**ACE Program**

- Any dog 18 months or older can jump one height lower than their Championship Standard Division height in the ACE Standard Division
- Any dog 10 years or older can jump two heights lower than their Championship Standard Division height in the ACE Senior Dog Division
- The original program is called the Championship Program.

**ENTRIES AND CHANGES** – Entries submitted prior to the Opening Date will *not* be accepted. Requests for changes or move-ups to your entry must be received in writing or email to the Trial Secretary by August 7, 2018. Day to day move-ups will be accepted.

**MEASURING - Dogs with a wither height of 20" or less will need show proof of measurement (i.e. AKC, ASCA or NADAC height card) or be measured at the trial, unless they are jumping in the highest jump height in that category/division.**

**TRIAL SITE INFORMATION**

The trial will be one ring, 117 x 80, artificial turf. Equipment may include the following: Dog walk (12' rubber) A-frame (rubber), teeter-totter, open tunnel, weave poles (24" spacing), jumps, double jump, displaceable tire.

**AWARDS** – First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run.

**HIGH IN TRIAL:** Rosettes for High in Trial Elite, Open, Novice, Aussie and Other Breed will be awarded for the WEEKEND. HIT calculations are based on scores from Jumpers, Gamblers and Regular in the Championship Program. Elite Q – 7 points, Open Q – 6 points, Novice Q – 5 points. Each faulted Q run (5 point Q) in Regular shall be given one-half the value of the equivalent level HIT Q points. Dog's entry in the Regular class will determine eligibility for each level's HIT (i.e. dog entered in Novice regular and Open Jumpers and Gamblers is eligible for Novice HIT). In the event of a tie, the dog with the fastest combined Regular YPS will be the winner. Dogs must have an ASCA registration or QTracking number and compete in the Championship Program to be eligible for HIT awards.

**If you may finish an ATCH during this trial, please inform the Trial Secretary before the trial.**

**FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)** - The minimum age for dogs entered in FEO is 15 months of age. Any dog younger than 18 months of age must jump at a lower height than their regular jump height. No points towards titles will be earned in this division.

**ASCA® ENTRY INFORMATION**

- All ASCA agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- Dogs do not have to have an ASCA registration or QTracking number to participate in an ASCA agility trial.
- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's ASCA registration number where designated on the entry form.
- If your dog is not an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you need to obtain an ASCA QTracking number for your dog. Any dog is eligible to get an ASCA QTracking number (not just Australian Shepherds). Once you have an ASCA QTracking number, use it as your dog's ASCA Registration Number. The ASCA Service Membership and QTracking Number Form can be obtained at the ASCA website ([www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org)) under "Forms" and will also be available at the trial.

**ENTRY FEES: Make checks payable to RRVASC**

**Pre-Entry Fees:**

Weekend package (6 runs per day, 12 runs total) \$130.00; one day (all 6 runs) \$65; individual runs \$12

Junior Handlers (entered in junior handler division) one-half of fees

**Day of show entry (if available):** \$16 per run. Entries accepted 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. each day.

**FOOD:** There will be no food available for purchase onsite. Drinks, lunch and snacks will be provided for workers, so please volunteer!

**WORKERS:** With 18 course changes, we can't hold these trials without the help of members and exhibitors to keep it running smoothly and efficiently. Your help is greatly appreciated! We will be happy to train those who are not familiar with the various positions. Sign-up sheet will be available day of trial! Thank you for being generous with your time!

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

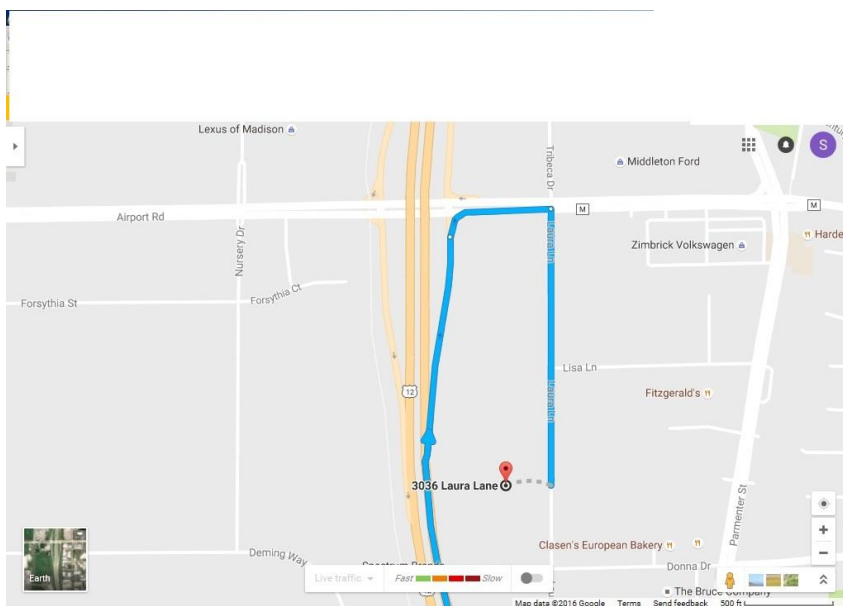
**Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA® rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.**

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) with Rock River Valley Australian Shepherd Club (RRVASC) as the sponsor club. Exhibitors through submission of their entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including the following rules regarding entry.

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA agility trials.
- The handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Pursuant to Section 1.3.7 of the ASCA Agility Rules, any dog displaying clinical symptoms of a communicable disease will be removed from the trial site, with no refund of entries. In the case of removal of a dog that shows symptoms of any contagious disease, all dogs in the same household or traveling with said dog shall also be removed.
- I (we) further agree that when my dog(s) are left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.

- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. Dogs must leave the ring on leash. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a member not in good standing with ASCA.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club's trial committee on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the closing date. **NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.** Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Puppies under eight weeks old and dog sales are not permitted on the trial site.
- Exercise dogs in designated areas, and clean up after your dog! Anyone witnessed not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial, with no refund of entries.
- Physical abuse of any animal will not be tolerated. Any person on the show site reported to have physically abused an animal will be ejected from the trial site for the entire trial weekend with no refund of entries, and will be subject to disciplinary action per ASCA rules.
- The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog that is being handled by a junior handler who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes may jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- The Veterans Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older. Dogs entered in the Veterans Division classes will jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook.

**AGREEMENT**

1.1 As used here "ASCA®" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA®, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA and RRVASC (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and Canine Sports Zone LLC and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor /owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
